

Canmore Registry & License Relocating to Alberta from Another Country (Reciprocal)

Clients originating from a country that has signed a "Reciprocal Licensing Agreement" with Alberta and who are lawfully entitled to be or to remain in Canada and have now established residency in Alberta may exchange their valid operator's License for an Alberta operator's License.

In addition to the **United States**, the following countries have a Reciprocal Licensing Agreement with Alberta:

- **Australia**
- **Austria**
- **Belgium**
- **Denmark** (Must provide 2 years driving history)
- **France**
- **Germany (Deutschland)**
- **Isle of Mann**
- **Japan**
- **Netherlands**
- **Northern Ireland**
- **Republic of Ireland**
- **Republic of Korea**
- **Switzerland**
- **Taiwan (Republic of China)**
- **Ukraine**
- **United Kingdom (UK)**

To obtain an Alberta Driver's License you are required to provide the following **two pieces of identification & one piece proving Alberta residency.**

IDENTIFICATION* **Driver's License with photo, plus one of the following:**

(If your Driver's License is not in English you are required to bring in a certified translation or a valid International Driver's Permit in English)

Passport + Work/Study/Visitor Permit (must have at least 90 days remaining)

OR

Permanent Residence Card/Certificate of Canadian Citizenship

***Neither temporary documents nor photocopies of documents will be accepted, all documents must be originals**

PROOF OF RESIDENCY* **One of the Following:**

Town of Canmore Tax or Water Bill

Residential lease or mortgage documents

Letter signed from employer on company letterhead

(Dated within the last 15 days)

Utility, telephone, gas or cable bill

Current bank &/or credit card statement

Income tax return

Pay Stub

***All proof of residency must be dated within the preceding 3 months.**

You will be required to surrender your out-of-country driver's license to Alberta Registries

If you have *lost* your out of country Driver's License, an official written confirmation from the country's licensing authority detailing the content of the Driver's License (including date first licensed & class of license held) is required

If your out-of-country driver's licence has *expired*, full re-testing is required

Learner's Licences from other jurisdictions will not be exchanged for Alberta Learner's Licences

To obtain a full-class 5 driver's licence, proof of 2 years driving experience must be provided.
(Issue date on your licence/driver's licence history report/driver's abstract)
